\_\_\_\_\_ **85330 THEATRE ARTS**-Designed as an introduction to theater, drama, public speaking, and stage design.  
**ADVANCED THEATRE ARTS** - Students perform and/or are a member of stage crew for UIL **One Act Play** and school performances. Considerable time outside of school during spring semester may be required. Students must maintain passing grades for eligibility.

\_\_\_\_\_ **86360 PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE)**

\_\_\_\_\_ **88302 LEADWORTHY (formerly Teen Leadership)** – Enables individuals to build personal responsibility, problem solving, and leadership skills through group activities, role-playing, speeches, and projects.

\_\_\_\_\_ **78460 (PLTW Gateway A) DESIGN & MODELING/AUTOMATION & ROBOTICS** - Discover the design process, creativity, innovation, and explore mechanical systems, automation, robotics, and computer control systems. This course may have limited availability.

\_\_\_\_\_ **78471 (PLTW Gateway B) COMPUTER SCIENCE FOR INNOVATORS & MAKERS/MEDICAL DETECTIVES** – Programming for the physical world (hardware design & software development), collect & analyze medical data to diagnose disease and solve medical mysteries. This course may have limited availability.

\_\_\_\_\_ **883123 SKILLS FOR LIVING/FAMILY CONSUMER SCIENCE**-Introduces students to career investigations and basic life skills (budgeting, cooking, sewing, health, and independent living). Students responsible for supplying some instructional materials for this class, not to exceed \$50 (example: materials such as recipe ingredients/sewing notions).

\_\_\_\_\_ **88360 TECHNOLOGY APPLICATIONS**-Year long course to introduce students to a variety of technology resources and programs that help them learn, create, collaborate, and think critically and publish their work.

**APPLICATION REQUIRED ELECTIVES: Student must complete/submit application & upon acceptance will be scheduled into class.**

**Media/Journalism/Yearbook** - Students develop media skills relevant to real world settings including surveying and researching information for news reports, producing and organizing the school announcements while practicing skills that are necessary for careers in the field of journalism.

**Student Aides: Office / CAP Center / Library**

**Selection is based on grades, attendance, attitude, and teacher recommendation.**

**AVID** Advancement Via Individual Determination prepares students for entrance into four-year colleges. Emphasis on analytical writing, preparation for college entrance/placement exams, study skills, test taking, note taking, organization, time management and research. **Requires enrollment in at least one Pre-AP class.**
